


What Is Pointillism?

Pointillism is an art technique of neo-impressionist painting. Pointillism and stippling are the same things, but the former is the original name. The basis of pointillism is creating a bunch of dots in different densities to create a cohesive image when viewers look at the bigger picture. It was developed by Georges Seurat in 1886 as a variation of the art form impressionism.

What You'll Need

- Paper
- Fine liners/liquid pens

When selecting your fine liner/pen, make sure the tip is as thin as possible and that the ink doesn't bleed when used on paper.
