What is folk art?

- Folk art does not follow academic art or any type of training, it has no set technique or theme
- It might be something you don't think of as art
- It can be made from ANY material
- Folk art has CREATIVE edginess or rawness
- It can be pottery, painting, or sculpture that reflect memories from childhood or images that stand out to the artist – this is called **narrative art**.
